

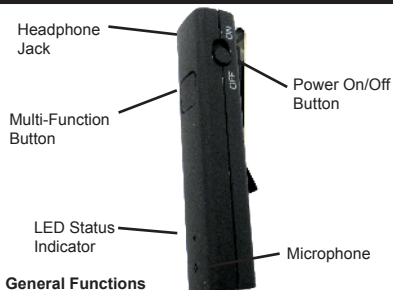


Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MightyMic W+ Bluetooth microphone. In order to use the mic as a wireless microphone you will need to use a compatible App such as MoviePro for video recording or MightyMic Pro Recorder for audio recording. Please check our website for the latest info on Apps and features.

Safety Rules

- To ensure your safety before using the MightyMic W+ please carefully read through this user manual
- Be wary of any sharp edges, uneven surfaces, metal parts, accessories and their packaging so as to prevent any possible injuries to you or to the microphone
- Do not modify, repair, or dismantle the microphone. Do so may result in fire, electric shocks, complete failure of this device, etc. All of which are not covered in the warranty
- Do not use any solvents or volatile liquids to clean the MightyMic W+
- Do not use the MightyMic W+ in a hazardous location
- The package contains small parts. Please keep away from children
- You must select a qualified charger from a reliable manufacturer
- Do not use the USB charging cable on any other device because of possible damage

General Functions

| Desired Result | Required Action |
|----------------|--|
| Turn On | Turn the power button to the On position The Blue LED will flash three times |
| Pairing Mode | When the device is OFF turn the "power" button to ON The blue LED and red LED will flash quickly alternately The mic will turn off automatically if not paired for 3 min |
| Pairing | Use a Bluetooth compatible iPhone, iPad, or Android device to perform the pairing action |
| Turn Off | Turn the "power" button to OFF position when the device is On to conserve battery usage . The Red LED will flash three times and then shut off |

| Desired Result | Required Action |
|-------------------------------|--|
| Standby/Record/ Playback Mode | The Blue LED will flash twice every 7 seconds |
| Multi-Function | Press the MF button to pause/play music Press the MF button twice to move to the next song |
| Delete Pairing | Quickly toggle the power switch between ON and Off or delete the pairing on the device |
| Charging | Plug the charging cable into the micro-USB jack (A red LED will be on while charging and turn to blue when the charging is complete) |
| Battery Power | Battery status will be shown on the top right corner of the phone screen after paired. (Only on IOS devices) |
| Answer/End Phone Call | Press the MF button once to answer a call Press the MF button once to end a call Press and hold the MF button for 2 sec to reject a call |

Pairing to an IOS or Android phone or iPad device

To use your Bluetooth Microphone, you must first pair it with a device. Once your Bluetooth Microphone is paired to a specific device, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.

Pairing Instructions:

- Turn on your Phone or device and insure the Bluetooth function is activated
- Using the button on the side of the microphone set it to the ON position for the pairing mode
- In the Settings App on the device select the Bluetooth option. Look for a Bluetooth device listed as "Ampridge WP" to pair it to the Microphone
- The display should change from "Not Paired" to "Connected"
- If you have paired before you may just need to touch the "Ampridge WP" device to reconnect or it may connect automatically

Charging your Bluetooth Microphone

This microphone uses a USB to micro-USB charging cable. Use a USB Phone charger (not included) to charge your device. Make sure that your device is fully charged before the initial use. Insert the USB terminal of your charging cable into a USB phone charger and connect the other terminal to the micro-USB jack on the microphone. While charging, the red LED on the front will remain on. When charging is completed, the LED will turn blue.

Using the MightyMic W+ Microphone

Make sure the MightyMic W is already paired to your phone or other device. Make sure your phone is set to airplane mode and Bluetooth enabled otherwise you may have recordings interrupted by unwanted calls.

To hear playback audio while the Bluetooth microphone is connected, swipe from the bottom to open the Control Center and select the airplay button (IOS Only). Manually choose the device as the option for playback.

Using the MightyMic W+ for video recording

- 1) Connect the Bluetooth microphone before the app starts. You may need to select the Bluetooth mic as an option in the settings of the App
- 2) With some Apps, if the Bluetooth microphone is connected after the app starts, the microphone symbol changes to blue to indicate a Bluetooth Microphone is active
- 3) If the Bluetooth Microphone is disconnected while the app is active, the app switches to the built-in microphone and the microphone symbol should change back to plain white.
- 4) To confirm the microphone is connected do a test recording or go into the Settings section. Upon leaving the Settings section the Bluetooth microphone will become active again and the "Microphone" symbol will appear again in blue.
- 5) Many updates are planned for Bluetooth options to further enhance the features. Please check the website for updates regarding this or other features.

Using the MightyMic W+ for audio recording

- 1) The MightyMic W+ will support audio App's designed to work with external Bluetooth devices.
- 2) An audio App is needed such as the MightyMic Pro Recording App to do Bluetooth audio recording. Please check our website for updates regarding this or other supported Apps.
